- WASL- formative and summative assessment. Writing: 4th grade piece, longest and most exhaustive piece of the exam (day long writing). 2 days of writing, not back-to-back. K-4 teachers work very much with this test in mind. Two sections of writing test, one narrarative and one expository. Math: is all grades 3-6 grade. Computation and problem solving. Spread out over several days. Emphasizing a lot on showing thinking and how answers were reached. Science: 5th grade test. Has been 2 day test. Engineering and research sides of science. Design and investigative functions. Lots of hands on to teach kids how to think scientifically. Reading: all grades. Fiction and non-fiction sections. Comprehension is assessed. Also analysis questions included. How we use the information: there is a score at the end. Gives snapshot of students levels and progress. General picture, scores are broken down by gender, cohort, previous years, grade level, etc. How we DON'T use the information: there is no sorting. WHEN: window is April 13th thru May 1st. Make-up is usually the final week of April. Usually tues, wed, thurs, of first week. No final date set yet. Daily schedule will change (recess, lunch etc.).
