PRINCIPAL'S REPORT Presented by Mark

TREASURER'S REPORT

- Monthly financials & Budget review
 - We are down on corporate matches and have yet to collect all contributions.
 - Escript contributions (Safeway purchases) are down and we collect less interest from bank accounts.
 - Currently \$3,352 short this year based on current projections
 - Discussed using constant contact as a way to collect contributions.
- 2012-2013 Annual budget discussion and preparation
 - Budget will need to be cut to match more closely what we bring in. We have now spent our surplus.
 - Ideas discussed: Lower fieldtrip, Friday special spending and other line items, charge for certain events, increase annual contribution slightly.
 - Outdoor Ed Expressed concerns over the cost, maturity of 4th graders, Thoreau takes 5th graders to Islandwood, Sandburg will discontinue outdoor ed after this yr.
 - Should we consider a fund raising event?
 - <u>Action Items</u>: Mark to discuss Outdoor Ed with Monica and take informal poll of 3rd graders. Questions: Can she forgo the big fall fieldtrip? Does she want both grades to go or nothing? What are her curriculum ideas?
 - Given that there were so many unanswerable questions, budget discussion was tabled.
